

# SC145 Public Address System

(1998)

(LSA Code, para. 7.2.2)

1. With respect to spaces where a public address system is/may not be required in 7.2.2.1, these may be spaces such as under deck passage way, bosun's locker, hospital, pump room.
2. With respect to cabin/state rooms, the sound pressure levels as stated in 7.2.2.2.1 shall be attained as required inside the cabin/state room, during sea trials.
3. Where an individual loudspeaker has a device for local silencing, an over-ride arrangement from the control station(s), including the navigating bridge, shall be in place.
